

Face the facts

To prevent this from happening:

- Never overload power points;
- Never connect power boards
 or double adaptors together
- Check power boards for signs of damage or discolouration. If found discard immediately.
- Buy quality power boards with an overload protection device or RCD
- Provide adequate ventilation around the power boards.
- Consider hiring a licensed electrician to install power points to avoid excessive use of power boards

Power Boards

REMEMBER: Power Points and Power Boards can cause a fire in your home
