i Electric blankets are a potential source of fire.



There are simple actions you can take to reduce the risk of fire when using electric blankets.



**TEST** electric blankets prior to use. If the blanket or cord is damaged do not use it.



## **KEEP CLEAR**

When in use, keep the blanket CLEAR of material that could cause it to overheat, such as lavers of blankets or piles of laundry.



## **PREPARE**

Inspect the electric blanket for discolouration caused by overheating or wear and tear before use (brown spots may indicate the blanket is overheating).



## **SWITCH OFF**

**SWITCH OFF** electric blankets before leaving the house and going to sleep.
