STAY WITH YOUR FIRE PIT WHENEVER IT'S LIT

Fire pits and outdoor fireplaces can be dangerous if not used correctly.



There are simple actions you can take to reduce the risk of fire when using a firepit.



KEEP CLEAR

The fire pit should be kept **CLEAR** of structures or foliage. Do not place the fire pit on a flammable surface.



PUT OUT

Always have continuous supply of water or a fire extinguisher ready to completely **PUT OUT** the fire when you are finished.



WATCH

Always have a responsible adult WATCH and control the fire. Only burn clean, dry, well-seasoned wood. Keep a WATCH on the weather, do not use a fire pit if it is too windy or there is a total fire ban.

Always WATCH children and pets around a fire pit.

Remove debris from last fire before starting a new fire.
