#### **Discussion:**

Michael Joyce reported that ACTRFS had a quiet fire season. However; ACTRFS brigades have been assisting the ACT State Emergency Services throughout the storm season.

The Mobile Data Terminals (MDT's) rollout is progressing well with completion expected in the next 3 to 4 weeks. This is part of the process of the Concept of Operations for Computer Aided Dispatch (CAD) to enable the Communication Centre to dispatch the nearest and most appropriate vehicle/appliance to an incident. Dispatch is done via MDT and backed up by a radio message. When units call in they will no longer be required to provide a map reference it will be automatically done via the Automatic Vehicle Locater (AVL). The system is on the 3G network with a trunk radio network backup.

The weather report for the upcoming season was provided. There is a possibility that an El Nino weather pattern for late 2012; however, it is too early to be definite.

The Commissioner tabled and provided a detailed overview of the Map of the Built Up Area (BUA) and the Draft Concept of Operations for Bush and Grass Fires in the Australian Capital Territory. The ACT Bushfire Council were advised they were the first to be consulted; further consultation with stakeholders is impending.

The Commissioner advised of jurisdiction in the *Emergencies Act 2004* identifies that the Chief Officer of the ACT Fire and Rescue (ACTF&R) is responsible for fire response in the built up area and the Chief Officer of the ACT Rural Fire Service (ACTRFS) is responsible for fire response in rural area.

The Commissioner advised that the intent is to have one set of arrangements known at the Concept of Operations. The built up area and response to bush and grass fires is a shared responsibility between ACTRFS and ACTF&R.

Detail of the doctrine discussed was the nature of bush and grass fires, requirements of the *Emergencies Act 2004*, community expectations, capability to combat bush and grass fires in a unified approach.

The Chief Officer ACTF&R and the Chief Officer ACTRFS conducted the review of the Built Up Area (BUA) map, which had not been updated since 2006. The final BUA map will be reviewed yearly.

ACT Bushfire Council Members were requested to review the map and read the draft discussion paper (out of session) and provide the Commissioner with comments.

It was agreed that members provide comments via Peter Beutel who will coordinate a response to the ESA Commissioner. Comments to be provide to Peter Beutel by Wednesday 25 April 2012.

Consultation regarding horse evacuation centres has commenced with the Equestrian Association, Will Andrew the ACT Government Veterinarian and the manager of Exhibition Park in Canberra. Mosaic grazing of paddocks for refuge use has been discussed.
